NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

**FENWAY DRIVE RECONSTRUCTION - 09
OPWC PROJECT # CM14M/CM15M**

BATH TOWNSHIP

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the Board of Allen County Commissioners, Allen County Courthouse, City of Lima, Ohio, until 11:00 A. M., April 2, 2009, at which time they will be opened and publicly read aloud. Bids will be for the reconstruction of the existing roadway in Bath Township by means of removing the existing asphalt/concrete pavement and replacing with a new cement stabilized sub-base, stone base, asphalt base course and 448 asphalt finish course. The finish course will consist of a 1-1/2" thick course of 448 asphalt concrete so as to obtain a 1/4" per foot cross slope in the pavement. Reconstruction will match existing pavement width. 448 Asphalt Concrete shall not contain recycled material. Aggregate to be used in hot mix shall be stockpiled, for sampling by county and testing at least two weeks before being used in hot mix. Stone stockpiles not passing Allen County Engineer's specifications as result of testing, shall be rejected for use in this contract. The total project length is approximately 3,640 feet all of which make up the Fenway Drive Reconstruction – 09 OPWC Project, an Issue 1 funded project. Also included in the project are 7,225 feet of combination curb and gutter. Catch basins will also be replaced, but most of the existing storm sewer lines, sanitary sewer and water lines will remain intact.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Allen County, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Department of Industrial Relations.

Specifications and contract bid documents may be obtained from the office of the Allen County Engineer; 1501 North Sugar Street; Lima, Ohio 45801. There will be a \$30.00 charge per set, which is non-refundable. Checks should be made payable to the Allen County Engineer.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guarantee and Contract Bond in accordance with Sections 153.54 and 153.571 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must provide evidence of its experience on projects of similar size and complexity, and a complete listing of all subcontractors to be used. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed no later than **August 1, 2009**.

All bids shall be sealed and addressed to the Board of Allen County Commissioners; P. O. Box 1243; Courthouse, Lima, Ohio 45802 and marked "**SEALED BID - FENWAY DRIVE RECONSTRUCTION - 09**" on the outside of the envelope.

No bidder shall be permitted to withdraw its bid for a period of thirty (30) days after the time of bid opening.

The Board of Allen County Commissioners, Allen County, Ohio reserves the right to reject any or all bids submitted or to waive any irregularities pursuant to Section 9.31 of the Revised Code.
